For a three- or four-part setting, use Voice 1, Voice 2 and Voice 3 (Voice 3 includes optional divisi).

Voice 1 should always be sung - but Voices 2 and 3 may be sung and/or played by any suitable instruments.

The piano/keyboard part should be sung/played throughout.


